Pastor's Corner

Reflexiones de tu Párroco

Our Christian faith invites us always to reflect truth and respect toward human beings and their institutions. In today's readings we discover that God reveals his presence to people of faith in history. Isaiah, for instance, recognizes in the Persian emperor Cyrus a good man, who freed the Israelites and supported the restoration of Jerusalem. The prophet insists that God is the one true God, in the midst of nations that worshiped many gods. St. Paul, in today's Second Reading, reminds the Thessalonians that the strength they find in the midst of difficulties is rooted in God who chose them and in the power of the Holy Spirit. In the Gospel, Jesus does not limit his words to recognizing the entrapment of the Pharisees; he also confronts their hypocrisy.

By so doing, he unveils the wisdom that God grants to those who respect human life at all stages and are willing to face the reality that they experience in the world, even if it is not the one they would envision as ideal. Today's readings can assist small parish groups in their ongoing reflections, as their members face difficult experiences in society despite their sharing of faith and personal witness at liturgical celebrations. They may ask each other: In what ways can truth and justice overcome the criticisms and rejections we experience from those around us? Where does our inner strength come from and how can we experience it every day?

Nuestra actitud de fe cristiana nos invita a reflejar siempre la verdad y el respeto a los seres humanos y a sus instituciones. Las lecturas nos invitan a reflexionar, sobre la forma en que Dios revela su presencia en distintos momentos de la historia de la salvación. Isaías reconoce en Ciro, el emperador persa, al hombre bueno que respetó la historia de Israel y ayudó a su restauración. El profeta revela a un Dios Único, en medio de naciones que adoraban muchos dioses. San Pablo recuerda a los tesalonicenses, de dónde proviene la fortaleza que los guía en medio de tantas vicisitudes: del Dios que los ha elegido y la fuerza del Espíritu Santo (segunda lectura). Jesús no se limita a reconocer la trampa que quieren hacerle los fariseos; al confrontarlos en su hipocresía.

Jesús revela la sabiduría que Dios concede a los que respetan la vida humana en cada etapa y enfrentan la realidad que comparten con otros, aunque no sea la experiencia ideal que esperaban (Evangelio). Estas lecturas pueden motivar el diálogo entre los grupos comunitarios, cuyos miembros se enfrentan a una realidad difícil en la sociedad, a pesar de la fe que comparten en las celebraciones litúrgicas y en su testimonio de vida. ¿De qué manera la verdad y la justicia pueden vencer la crítica y las mentiras de los que a veces nos rechazan? ¿De dónde proviene nuestra fortaleza y cómo la experimentamos a diario?
